The poster session will provide an opportunity to present breaking research results and innovative work currently in progress and to discuss these with symposium delegates. A prize will be awarded to the best poster during the afternoon session of the Symposium.

The focus of the MindTech Symposium is how technology can be used to improve mental health. You are invited to present current or latest research results and/or report on the progress and impact of innovative projects. **Your poster should not be a sales pitch.**

We are particularly keen to hear about research that is led by or involves patients, service users and the public. We particularly encourage submissions from students and early stage researchers.

#### Submission details

You should submit an abstract of no more than 500 words describing the research that will be presented in the poster. Please include the names and affiliations of all authors and details of how the work was funded. One of the poster authors must be registered to attend the symposium.

#### Review Process

We have a committee who will be reviewing all the submitted abstracts. The committee includes people with a wide range of experiences of mental health and technology including service users, researchers, clinicians and developers. The committee will make their decisions based on quality of content, relevance to practice, originality and innovation.

Authors will be informed of the outcome of the reviews by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
